...be doers of the word, and not bearers only... (James 1:22, ESV)

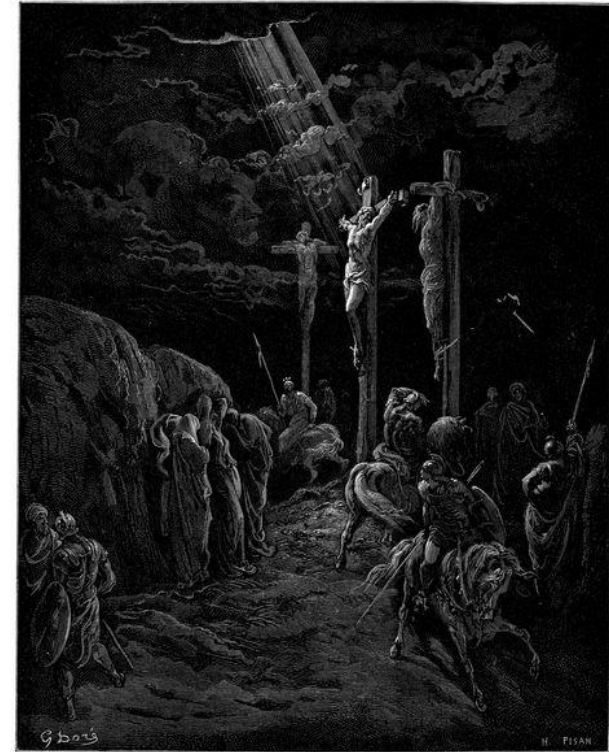
