...*be doers of the word, and not bearers only*... (James 1:22, ESV)

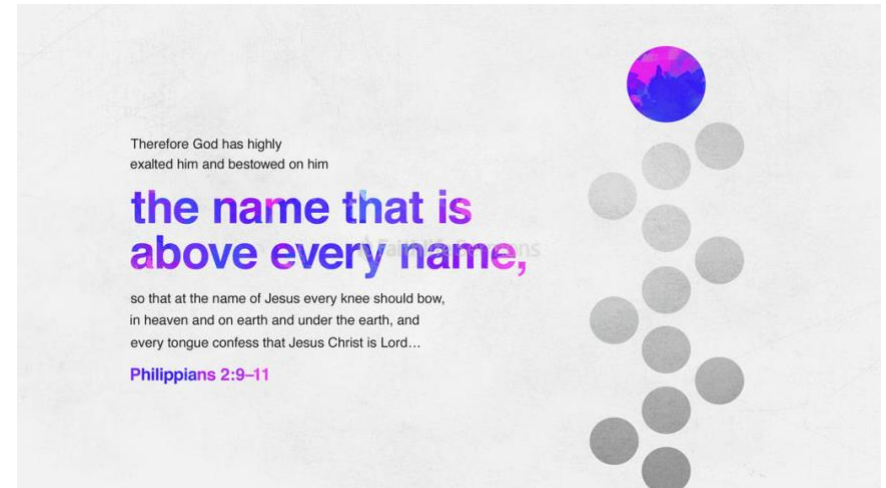

Your responsibility, by God's enabling, is to consistently apply the divine principles and truths you have heard (Philippians 2:12-13; 1 Timothy 4:7-9; James 1:22-27).

As you meditate on this message, ask yourself these questions:

- How does God want my beliefs and/or actions to change?
- How can I accomplish this change?
- What is the first step toward bringing about this change?

1. What is the name above all names?
2. Why is two-stage Christianity (“accept Christ as Savior, then make Him Lord later”) so dangerous? How did this subvert the biblical gospel?
3. Perhaps you have heard some well-meaning preacher say something like this: “If Christ isn’t Lord of all, He’s not Lord at all!” How does Paul refute that in vv. 9-11?
