

## Application Questions

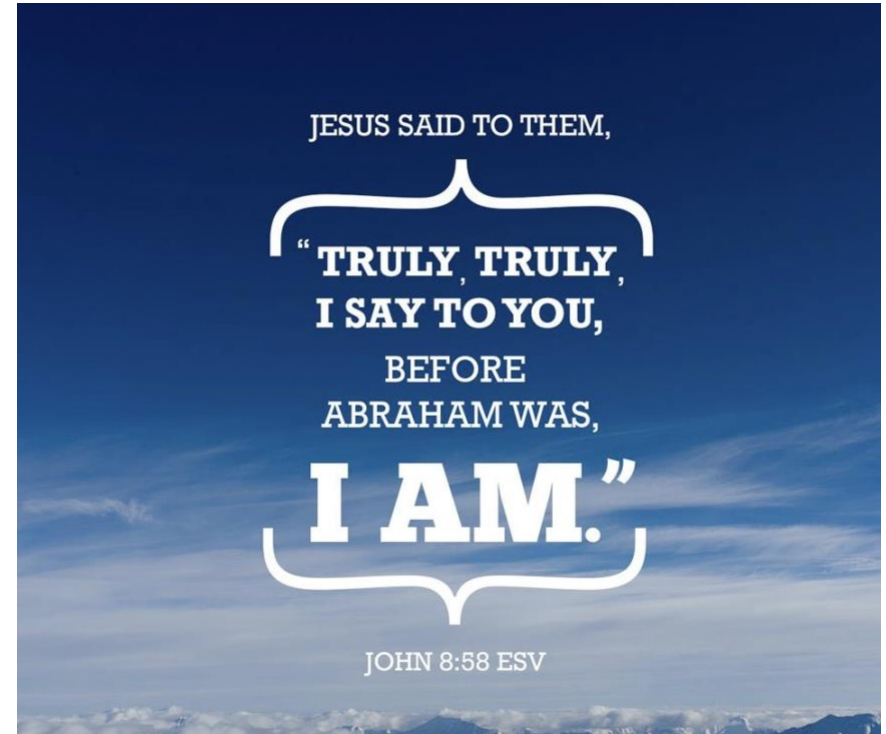
...*be doers of the word, and not bearers only*... (James 1:22)
