

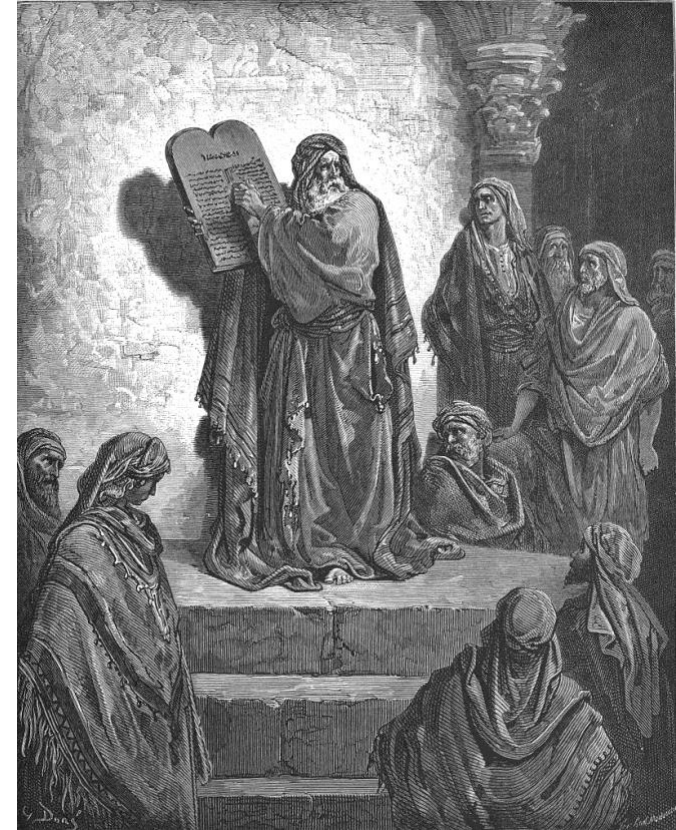
# Application Questions
