As you meditate on this message, ask yourself these questions:

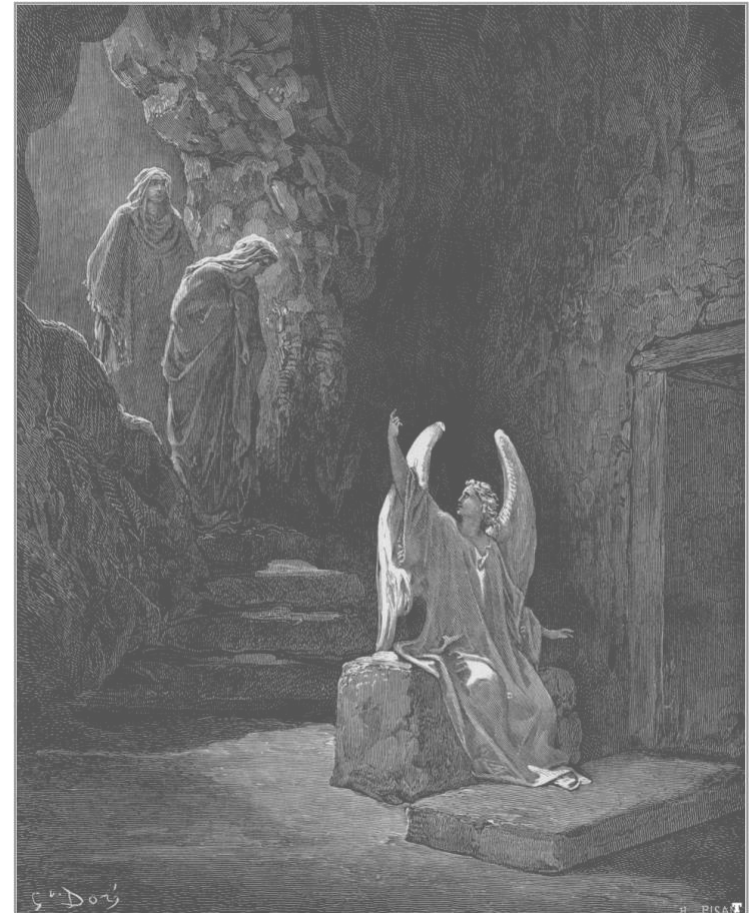
- How does God want my beliefs and/or actions to change?
